





## Activity Report: Visit to Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya by Prof. (Dr.) Anil Kumar Sarkar

**Date:** February 22, 2023

**Institutions Involved:** Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya and Garia Society for Studies of Marginal People.

### Overview:

On February 22, 2023, Prof. (Dr.) Anil Kumar Sarkar, Professor in History at Calcutta University, visited the History Department at Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya as part of an ongoing Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the two institutions start on 22.12.2021. The primary objective of the visit was to facilitate academic exchange and promote excellence in teaching and learning.

### Activities:

Presentation on *Mahatma Gandhi and Modern Civilisation*:

Prof. Sarkar delivered a comprehensive presentation to the students of the Department of History, Philosophy and Political Science of Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya on the *Mahatma Gandhi and Modern Civilisation*. The presentation covered the following topics:

- Introduction.


### Question & Answer Session:


### Outcomes:

## Activity Report: Visit to Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya by Mr. Mahan Haldar

**Date:** February 23, 2023

**Institutions Involved:** Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya and Garia Society for Studies of Marginal People.

### Overview:

On February 23, 2023, Mahan Haldar, Ph.D. scholar at Kalyani University, visited the History Department at Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya as part of an ongoing Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the two institutions start on 22.12.2021. The primary objective of the visit was to facilitate academic exchange and promote excellence in teaching and learning.

### Activities:

*Presentation on Revolt of 1857: Causes & Effects of the Revolt.*

Mr. Haldar delivered a comprehensive presentation to the students of the Department of History of Jibantala Rokeya Mahavidyalaya on the Presentation on Revolt of 1857: Causes & Effects of the Revolt. The presentation covered the following topics:

- Causes of 1857 Revolt: Social and Religious Causes, Economic Causes, Military Grievances, Political Causes.
- Leaders Associated with the Revolt of 1857.
- British Officials Associated with Revolt.
- The Revolt of 1857 eventually broke out over the incident of greased cartridges.
- In March 1857, Mangal Pandey, a sepoy in Barrackpore, had refused to use the cartridge and attacked his senior officers.
- India now came under the direct rule of the British Crown.

### Interactive Session:

Following the presentation, Mr. Haldar engaged the students in an interactive session where they had the opportunity to ask questions, seek clarification, and discuss their experiences with Presentation on Revolt of 1857: Causes & Effects of the Revolt. This session encouraged active participation and facilitated knowledge sharing among the students and the visiting scholar.

### Question & Answer Session:

Mr. Mahan Haldar addressed queries raised by the students regarding significance of the revolt, outcome of the revolt, affect the British East India Company, impact of the revolt on Indian society etc.
