- For most of the 20th century International Women's Day was acknowledged and celebrated by people at the grassroots level, a rallying point for social justice. It was not until 1975 – International Women's Year – that the United Nations adopted International Women's Day on 8 March.
- The United Nations (UN) theme for International Women's Day (IWD) 2023 was "DigitALL: Innovation and Technology for Gender Equality". The theme acknowledged the role technology plays in the gender divide, and that the digital world can benefit men and boys more than women and girls. The campaign called for:
 - Treating women as technology creators and decision-makers
 - Including women equally in the design, development, and deployment of technology
 - Working together to make the planet fairer for all, both on- and offline

Introduction

- International Women's Day (8 March) is a day to join voices with people around the world and strive for equal rights irrespective of the diversities, the facets and intersections of faith, race, ethnicity, gender or sexual identity, or disability. It is also a time to celebrate the achievements of women, whether social, political, economic, or cultural. It is a time to celebrate the achievements of those who came before us, those who stand beside us now, and those who will come after.
- In 1908, against a backdrop of terrible working conditions and exploitation, 15,000 women had taken to the streets in New York protesting for shorter hours, better pay and voting rights. The next year the Socialist Party of America announced a National Women's Day to honour the strikers, and in 1910 it went global – the Socialist International voted for the creation of a Women's Day to advocate for suffrage. The first International Women's Day was held in 1911, and more than a million people turned out to rallies in Europe.

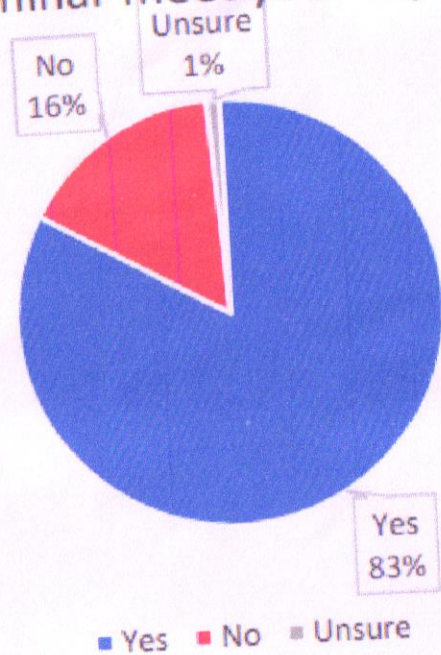

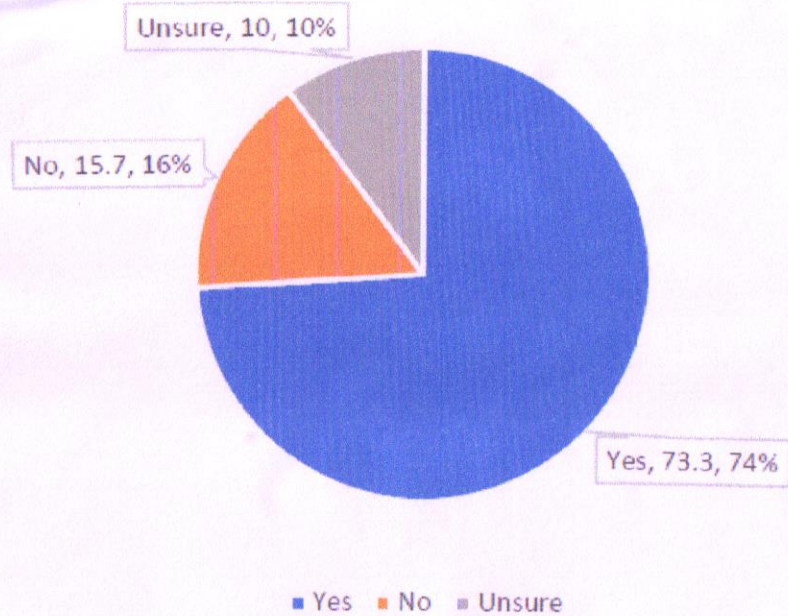
